


FIRST DAY

Then we went to the castle from which it was possible to see the whole panorama.




On the castle square we spent about 2 hours doing various photo assignments.

SECOND DAY


The second day was definitely the heaviest. We were up at 4 am to get to the sunrise. We were tired and sleepy, but the views of the rising sun were






We were able to make some pictures of the empty Charles Bridge which is impossible. There were several other photographers who did not bother to


take pictures.

shots there.








There are stairs leading to the castle and in the afternoon it is hard to move


around them.






On the way back to the hotel I also took pictures of places where it is never

Then we went to the Charles Bridge and then to the hotel.






After an hour's break we went to the Golden Alley. I do not have a picture because I did not like it very much and there were a lot of people ©. Then we went to the square and made some
